
#### *How* does the IA Foundation *donate?*

Insurance Advisernet and its Foundation has contributed over \$2 million over the last 5 years to over 30 different charities. We aim to donate over \$400,000 each year through a variety of fundraising initiatives. 2019/2020 has been an unprecedented and turbulent year which has seen fires, storms, floods and of course, COVID-19.

#### **SAHMRI**

The SAHMRI (South Australian Health and Medical Research Institute) is an independent flagship organisation dedicated to improving health outcomes, both in Australia and around the world. One of their research areas is Heart Health and IA is proud to provide a range of insurances to SAHMRI for the multiple clinical trials being conducted by this department. In fact, it was the provision of these insurances that led to IA donating a further \$25,000 to SAHMRI to actively support one of their Peripheral Arterial Deisease Projects.

This funding follows on from last year's donation which supported their Heart Health Program.

Approximately 1 in 5 patients with peripheral arterial disease will suffer a major adverse cardiovascular event over a 12-month period. Atherosclerotic risk factors in patients with PAD are disappointingly under recognised and undertreated in the community. This disease burden is expected to increase significantly over the next 20 years due to our aging population and our changing risk factor profiles.

This project examines the effects of medical and lifestyle therapy on symptoms, functional capacity, quality of life and cardiovascular health compared with standard treatment.

With the generous support of IAF, SAHMRO have been able to investigate many aspects of peripheral artery disease. From this research, they have identified significant gender differences in mortality. Understanding the factors contributing to this discrepancy is essential. We believe this is key to improving care for all patients with this condition.

*\$25,000* Donation



The IA donation of \$25,000 will help to pay for vital research into PAD.



Insurance Advisernet and one of their Insurer partners, TravelCard, travelled early last month through bushfire affected towns on the NSW South Coast (starting in Batemans Bay, traveling onto Mogo, Moruya, Bermagui, Cobargo and culminating at Merimbula). We were fortunate enough to have Travelcard's corporate ambassador Catriona Rowntree with us given our purpose was to demonstrate these towns are "open for business" following the damage sustained.

The IA Foundation also took the opportunity to donate funds to hard-working local charities involved in the community's recovery where over \$50,000 was donated to worthy groups assisting this cause.

We encourage anyone thinking of their upcoming holidays (when it is safe to travel) to consider these wonderful coastal and historic towns as well as any other catastrophe affected townships across the Country.

#### **JDRF**

JDRF is the largest charitable funder and advocate of Type 1 Diabetes (T1D) research in the world. Their aim is to raise enough money so that this disease and its complications will not only be treated effectively, but also prevented and even cured in the near future. Known as the silent pandemic, Diabetes Australia estimates that 280 Australians develop diabetes every day with 10% suffering from T1D (85% suffer from Type 2 Diabetes and 5% from gestational diabetes).

Each year, JDRF stages the 'JDRF One Walk', a month long challenge whereby participants walk 120,000 steps to support 120,000 Australians living with T1D to help raise research funds and the Insurance Advisernet (IA) Foundation is very happy to continue its support of this event. IA first became involved in 2016, donating \$10,000 to 'Hayley's Heroes', a fundraising team organised by IA Authorised Representative Simon Feldman of Sound Insurance Services in Melbourne.

Simon's young daughter was diagnosed with T1D in 2014 when she was just 11 years old, and Hayley's Heroes takes part in the JDRF One Walk every year to help raise money for research.

JDRF continually strives to improve the lives of people suffering from T1D by funding national and international research with the express aim of eradicating this disease. To date, this organisation has raised \$2.25billion for research, with \$152m million invested in Australian research.

The IA Foundation is a strong supporter of our community and takes great pleasure in continuing its support of this worthy cause.

Recently, the IA Foundation were pleased to donate \$5,000 to the Chris O'Brien Lifehouse on behalf of SurFebruary. The \$5,000 donation was presented to Dr Judith Lacey who is the Head of Supportive Care and Integrative Oncology at Chris O'Brien Lifehouse, accompanied by Matthew Counsel from Altius Group, Jenna Clark from SurFebruary and Sophie Beer of Insurance Advisernet.

The Chris O'Brien Lifehouse is a not-for-profit, comprehensive cancer hospital. From screening to prevention, diagnosis, treatment and wellness, they specialise in advanced care for patients with cancer, including the most rare and complex cases. Each year they treat over 57,000 patients from across Australia, using the latest technology in a modern, purpose-built hospital.

The funds donated by the IA Foundation will go towards providing evidence-based complementary therapies in partnership with clinical care delivered by Chris O'Brien Lifehouse. Given the expense of cancer treatment, these funds will provide access to those who otherwise could not afford it.




#### **EPILEPSY QLD**
