MENS SHED ASSOCIATION

BRISBANE YOUTH SERVICE

*\$25,000*Donation

Insurance Advisernet Foundation is proud to continue its longstanding support for Brisbane Youth Services (BYS) with a generous donation of \$25,000. BYS has a rich legacy of developing innovative services that address the evolving needs of vulnerable youth and young families in Brisbane. Currently, BYS employs nearly 100 dedicated staff members who offer a comprehensive range of programs and services to support young people aged 12-25 and their children.

In the 2023-24 period, BYS reported that almost 50% of the young people seeking their help were homeless, with 77% living in unsafe, temporary, or overcrowded housing. Laura Watson, Fundraising Coordinator, emphasised the severity of the situation: "The ongoing lack of safe and affordable housing options, combined with insufficient support services, has left a growing number of youths vulnerable or homeless."

The donation from the Insurance Advisernet Foundation will directly support BYS in delivering critical services such as emergency relief, housing provisions, physical and mental health initiatives, drug and alcohol intervention programs, parenting guidance, and domestic violence prevention measures. These services are essential in helping young people transition out of crisis and into safer, more stable futures.
